

GA & NREMT EMT-I & EMT-P Recertification

I have received many questions regarding recertification. Hopefully the following will help answer your questions.

1. As of October 1st 2007, the Georgia State Office of EMS/Trauma allows all 40 hours of continuing education to be acquired by distributive information. Distributive education includes; on-line, magazine, and other forms of non-contact learning.
2. Only 10 hours of distributive education can be used toward the recertification requirements for the NREMT recertification process.
3. NREMT requirements can be found at www.nremt.org under re-registration procedures.
4. As of October 1st 2007, the NREMT is allowing re-registration by examination. See nremt.org for details.
5. WHEN obtaining CEU's through distributive information please verify that the courses have been state or CECBEMS approved.
